WHEREAS, William Henry Everette Cobble was a dedicated and faithful servant for the City of Bloomfield serving as a Councilman on the Bloomfield City Council for 22 years and served on the Bloomfield Tobacco Festival committee for a number of years.

WHEREAS, Henry, was a 32-year employee of Heaven Hill Distilleries, a member of Wakefield Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon, and Old Kentucky Home Chapter of Order of the Eastern Star Number 436.

WHEREAS, on April 10, 1989, the City of Bloomfield did not have a uniform street numbering system until an ordinance was adopted to approve **Henry** submitting a uniform numbering system to the US Postal Service and the Council resolved that the number shall be visible from all addresses. This numbering system is in effect to this day.

WHEREAS, Henry was born April 10, 1946 and Almighty God has seen fit to call him to Eternal Rest on September 23, 2013 at the young age of 67, leaving behind wife Sandra (Hahn) Cobble and two sons, Robbie Cobble and Joey (Misty) Cobble and two grandchildren, Mariah and Logan Cobble; his parents-in law Robert and Dora Hahn, all of Bloomfield, Kentucky. He was preceded in death by his parents, Jake and Violet Pollard Cobble
