For the passing of Geraldine Simpson, this resolution of the Bloomfield City Council expresses the deep and profound sorrow to her husband, Mike Simpson, sons, Gilly Simpson and Randy Burba and four grandchildren.

WHEREAS, Almighty God has seen fit to call Geraldine Simpson to Eternal Rest on Tuesday, November 25, 2008, at a young age of 71. Living in Bloomfield most of her life, she was a native of Washington County, born as Geraldine Bottom to the late Willis and Lottie Bottom on March 23, 1937.

WHEREAS, Geraldine was a dedicated and faithful servant for the City of Bloomfield as she served several terms on the City of Bloomfield Board of Adjustments, Bloomfield Housing Authority and the Bloomfield All Kentucky Cities Committee.

FURTHERMORE, Geraldine was instrumental in the formation of the steering committee that founded the Bloomfield Community of Tomorrow group and was a driving force for the various projects that enhanced the Bloomfield downtown district and surrounding area. She encouraged community involvement in the preservation of Bloomfield's heritage and it's historical character.

FUTHERMORE, Geraldine was crowned Bloomfield Tobacco Festival Queen in 1954 and graduated from Bloomfield High School in 1955. She received the Nelson County Distinguished School Alumni Award in 2003. She was an active member of St. Michael the Archangel Catholic Church of Fairfield Kentucky and was a member of the Bloomfield Ret Hats.
