In the absence of Mayor Ronnie Bobblett Council Member and Presider Liz Gillis called to order the Bloomfield City Council special meeting at 6:00 p.m. at the Northeast Nelson Firehouse. Other Council members present were Henry Cobble, Tina J. Long, Mark Mays, Walter Pozgay and Richard Sweazy. City Attorney Jim Willett, Public Works Superintendent Ben Long and Police Chief Mike Cotton were also present.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR NELSON COUNTY REVIEW: Jan Johnston, Director for the Joint City-County Planning Commission, presented the City Council maps and text for land use within the city limits and contiguous growth areas. She asked the Council for future transportation plans such as connector roads. She also requested the City include plans for where the wastewater pump stations and force main will be located. She needed Ben Long to verify all city water lines.
