Mayor Ronnie Bobblett brought the special meeting of the Bloomfield City Council to order at 6:40 p.m. at the Bloomfield City Hall Conference Room (moved from the Northeast Nelson Firehouse). Those present were Henry Cobble, Liz Gillis, Mark Mays, and Richard Sweazy. Walter Pozgay joined the council later in the evening.

BUDGET WORKSHOP: After reviewing the entire proposed 2008-2009 annual budget as presented by the mayor the council proceeded in voting on salary increases for the city employees. Gillis made a motion, duly seconded by Sweazy, to grant a 4% increase to all base salaries. *Motion carried by a 3-1 vote.* The nay vote belonged to Mays as he was in favor of a 5% increase.

ADJOURNMENT: Mays made a motion, duly seconded by Sweazy, to adjourn at 8:30 p.m. *Motion carried by unanimous decision.*
