Mayor Ronnie Bobblett called to order the Bloomfield City Council special meeting at 5:50 p.m. at the Northeast Nelson Firehouse. Council members present were Henry Cobble, Tina J. Long, Liz Gillis, Mark Mays, Walter Pozgay and Richard Sweazy. Police Chief Mike Cotton was also present.

**LAND USE PLAN – CITY OF BLOOMFIELD:** Jan Johnston, Director for the Joint City-County Planning Commission reviewed maps and text for land use within the city limits of the City of Bloomfield and contiguous growth areas. City Council members reviewed the correctness of the current land use as reflected on the maps. Next the Council discussed future growth of residential, commercial and industrial areas. They then formulated a plan for connectivity routes that would ease traffic flow through the city. Finally Johnston asked the Council if they would be interested in possibly planning a future bike path, as more and more people are becoming aware of the need for physical exercise. With their consent she would work up a plan and bring it back to a council meeting.
