Mayor Ronnie Bobblett called to order the Bloomfield City Council special meeting at 6:30 p.m. at the Bloomfield Civic Center at 155 Arnold Lane, Bloomfield, Ky. Attending were council members Henry Cobble, Liz Gillis, Tina Long, Mark Mays, Walter Pozgay and Richard Sweazy. City Attorney Jim Willett, Public Works Superintendent Ben Long, Kentucky Standard Editor Lydelle Abbott were also present.

**MINUTES AND FINANCIAL REPORTS:** Council members were mailed a copy of last month's regular meeting minutes whereby the reading was waived. Mays made a motion, duly seconded by Sweazy, to approve the meeting minutes. *Motion carried by unanimous decision.* Pozgay made a motion, duly seconded by T. Long, to approve the financial reports as presented. *Motion carried by unanimous decision.*

**RESIGNATION:** After submitting a letter of resignation from the Bloomfield City Council (effective Monday, January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2009) to the mayor, Council Member Tina Long expressed her appreciation for the her experience and lessons learned as a council member for the last 4 years.

**CABLE TV FRANCHISE TRANSFER:** Sweazy made a motion, duly seconded by Gillis, to approve the *Resolution 2008-75*; a resolution approving the Transfer of the Cable Franchise Agreement from the Insight Kentucky Partners II, L.P. to the City of Bardstown Cable. This resolution included that the Transfer is in accordance with the requirements of the Franchise, have filed an FCC Form 394 with the Franchise Authority purporting to include all information required by applicable law. *Motion carried by unanimous decision.*

Gillis made motion, duly second by Cobble, to adjourn the meeting at 7:05 p.m. A holiday reception followed for those in attendance.
