—	2-13-70	Approving an agreement between the cities of Bardstown, Bloomfield, Fairfield, and New Haven, and the County of Nelson, establishing a joint city-county Planning Unit, Planning Commission and Boards of Adjustment.
—	4-28-70	Approving an agreement between the cities of Bardstown, Bloomfield, Fairfield, and New Haven, and the County of Nelson, establishing a joint city-county Planning Unit, Planning Commission and Boards of Adjustment.
